

FAMILY FRIENDLY DINING OPTIONS ON NANTUCKET

*** Don't Miss!

Downtown - *Always lively in July and August. Expect a wait if reservations aren't available.*

*** Juice Bar – A must-do on Nantucket! Long lines for ice cream, but worth every second (and penny). Cash only.

Lobster Trap – New England-style seafood in town. Takes reservations for parties greater than six.

The Tavern – Casual patio great for people watching and something for everyone. Next to the Gazebo.

Brotherhood of Thieves – Hearty pub fare. We recommend sitting upstairs or outside with kids.

Slip 14 - Charming spot with great food and lively patio, especially late at night. Takes reservations.

Oath Pizza – Fast pizza to go or eat at their limited tables on the dock next to the Hy-Line ferry.

“The Strip” – Between the Steamship Authority Ferry and the Juice Bar, you'll find many fast-food options.

Mid-Island- *Shorter wait, more casual and easier parking than downtown if you are in a rush.*

*** LOLA Burger – Mid-island at the rotary. Simple menu with great burgers, milk shakes and fries.

*** Island Kitchen – Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner with a fun menu.

Pi Pizzeria - Great thin crust pizza and Italian food with cozy ambiance.

Fusaro's - Kid-friendly Italian food.

SeaGrille - Excellent seafood and children's menu. Takes reservations.

Kitty Murtagh's – Casual Irish pub with quick service.

Sophie T's Pizza – Easy place to take-out pizza loved by kids across the island.

Keeper's – New in 2017! Will have a great kid's menu and lots of seating.

Outside of Town

*** Millie's – Casual Baja-style seafood in Madaket with beautiful sunsets. Take out window and small market.

*** Cisco Brewery – Food trucks with many different options in a very kid-friendly spot.

Brant Point Grill at the White Elephant – Just outside town. Sunday Brunch features a special Kids' Corner. Large restaurant with harbor views. Takes reservations.

Breeze Restaurant at the Nantucket Hotel - Just outside town. Takes reservations.

The Sandbar at Jetties – Newly owned this year, can't beat the view!

Claudette's – Sandwich shop in Siasconset.

Sconset Market – Ice cream, bakery, deli meats and fancy groceries.

Miacomet – A great, easy options for families looking for a casual meal.

*** Downyflake – A Nantucket tradition. Diner with not to miss doughnuts. Mid-island, also has take-out entrance.
