CALMER WATERS

- 1 Jetties Beach | Close to town with parking, playground and the Sandbar restaurant.
- 2 Brant Point | Scenic lighthouse, the best place on island to watch the boats and ferries ‘round the point.
- 3 Children’s Beach | Closest beach to town, ideal for children with a playground, stage and snack bar, the Hungry Minnow.
- 4 Steps Beach | Picturesque beach between Dionis and Jetties Beach with views of the Nantucket Sound and Great Point.
- 5 Dionis | Calm waters and peaceful beach, restrooms, parking and a 3-mile bike ride from town.
- 6 40th Pole | A local favorite, drive on access, calm water with views of Smith’s Point and the Cape.

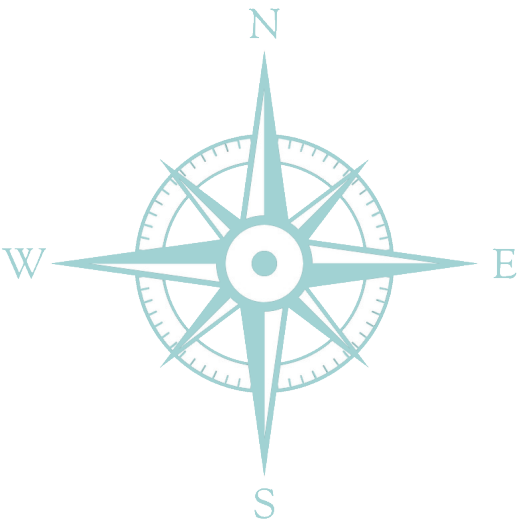
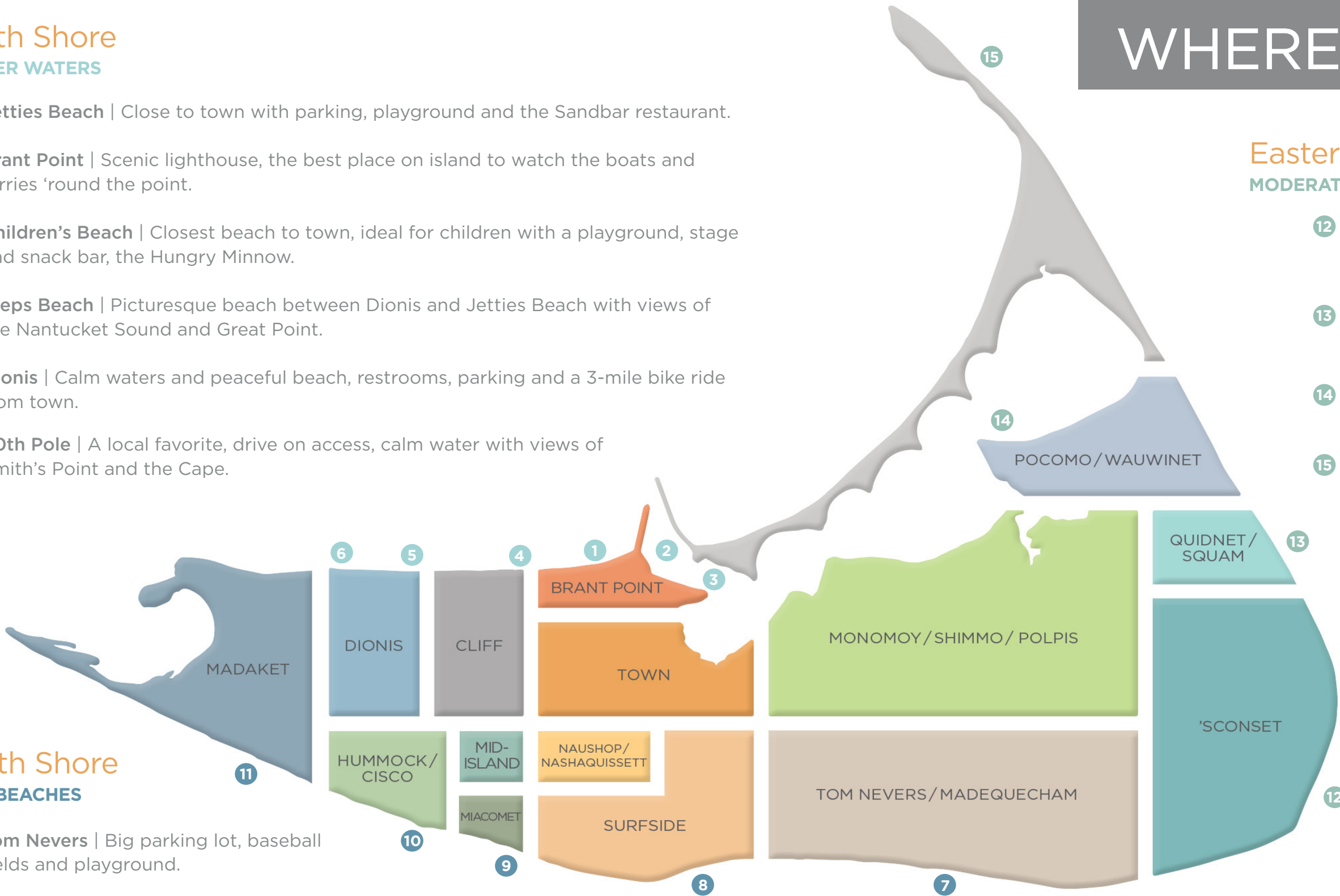
South Shore

- 7 Tom Nevers | Big parking lot, baseball fields and playground.
- 8 Surfside | Popular beach with shuttle services, restrooms, parking & bike racks.
- 9 Miacomet | 2.5 miles from town, not as busy as other South Shore beaches
- 10 Cisco | Surf school on-site, food cart, can be very busy.
- 11 Madaket | Famous sunset destination, portable restrooms & down the street from Millie’s Restaurant & Millie’s Market.

MODERATE SURF BEACHES

- 12 ‘Sconset | NRTA shuttle or a 6-mile bike ride. Food nearby in ‘Sconset Village.
- 13 Quidnet | No facilities or lifeguards. Borders Sesachacha Pond.
- 14 Pocomo | Warm water, great for kayaking.
- 15 Great Point Beach | Permit and 4-wheel drive required.
